## Route Delivery Responsibilities:

Route Delivery employees are responsible for completing delivery routes in a productive, timely fashion, while meeting customer needs.

- Must be customer-focused, friendly, and willing to "go the extra mile" to make sure our customers are 100% satisfied with their delivery experience. Our employees set a positive impression of Culligan in the communities we serve.
- Responsible for ordering stops in the most effective manner possible, using tools such as mapping software and plat books, but also personal experience on the best way to run the route to minimize miles and meet customer expectations.
- Safely operate Culligan delivery/service vehicles and forklift in a lawful manner.
- Use a cell phone application and/or delivery tickets to charge customers for the merchandise they receive and document any customer needs and/or changes made to accounts. Employees are responsible for maintaining accurate records of product delivered, inventoried, or damaged. All payments collected from customers are the employee's responsibility until they are turned in at the end of the route day.
- Become knowledgeable about Culligan's products and equipment, able to generate new business and spot sales opportunities.

Delivery employees are responsible for completing warehouse/shop responsibilities as part of the team that works in the area:

- Load delivery truck accurately so that all customers receive the correct products they are expecting.
- Perform a daily safety and maintenance check of Culligan vehicle(s) that you will be operating. Responsible for reporting any issues to management and scheduling routine maintenance.
- Use forklift to safely and efficiently load/unload delivery truck and maintain product in warehouse.

- Clean the inside/outside of your assigned delivery truck, the warehouse, grounds, and office daily or as needed.
- Assemble equipment, clean/maintain bottled water coolers, regenerate portable exchange tanks, and assist other employees upon request.

- Physical appearance is important. Culligan provides work clothing and expects our employees to have good personal hygiene and present themselves in a manner that is well-groomed and professional.
